

Jarrett 'Jerry' McLaughlin Scholarship Application 2022

Background: Jerry McLaughlin was an avid golfer who loved helping kids, and in particular, those who were passionate about the sport of golf. Jerry was a long time member of the Caribou Country Club and when he passed away his family established the Jarrett 'Jerry' McLaughlin Memorial Scramble and two \$500 scholarships in his remembrance. Awarded to graduating seniors and students enrolled in post secondary education (4-yr, 2-yr, and technical programs) who are members of the local golfing community, either with the CHS Golf Team or within the CCC family of golfers. As a one time award, this scholarship is targeted specifically towards graduating CHS Seniors, but is open to post secondary students if there are no viable CHS senior applicants. The scholarship will be selected by a committee consisting of the CCC Youth Golf Committee Chair and two additional CCC directors. This is a single payment, non-recurring scholarship. The scholarship will be awarded during the commencement of the 8th Annual Memorial Scramble, scheduled 20 August, 2022.
